#### Congratulations

Congratulations on the birth of your child whom we are delighted to welcome into our Christian community here in Corofin/Belclare. In Baptism, your child will be acknowledged and affirmed as a child of God. Baptism is the first step in your child's faith journey. By requesting the Sacrament of baptism for your child, you are giving a commitment that you will bring your child up in the practice of the faith. We in turn are committed to supporting your family on this journey and we look forward to celebrating the Sacraments of First Penance, First Holy Communion and Confirmation with your child in due course. Parents requesting Baptism for their child should therefore be practicing Catholics who bring their children to mass regularly.

## **Choosing Godparents**

Your child's godparents are required to be members of the Catholic Church who have celebrated all three sacraments of initiation; Baptism, Communion and Confirmation. Godparents play an important role in supporting the parents to hand on their faith to their child, so they themselves should be practicing Catholics. However, at the request of the parents, a baptised and believing Christian, not belonging to the Catholic Church, may also act as a Christian witness along with a Catholic godparent.

## Symbols used in the ceremony:

**Water** – the symbol of life,

Holy Oils, symbols of God's blessing and protection,

The **Christening gown/shawl**, a symbol of new life and purity

A **lighted candle**, representing the handing on of the faith to the next generation.

Your child's baptism will be recorded in the **Baptism Register** which will also record your child's confirmation and marriage or ordination.

#### **Part One: Ceremony of Welcome**

**Priest to Parents:** What name have you chosen for your child?

**Parents:** N.N. Each set of parents says the name of their child.

**Priest:** What do you ask of God's church for your child?

Parents: Baptism.

**Priest to Parents:** You have asked to have your child baptised. In doing so, your are accepting the responsibility of bringing your child up in the practice of the faith. Will you tell your child about God and teach your child to pray, to value life, to be just, truthful and kind, to respect and care for others and will you bring your child to Mass?

Parents: We will.

**Priest to Godparents:** Will you support this child and help these parents to hand on their faith to their child?

Godparents: We will.

**Priest:** On behalf of our Christian community, I welcome your child and I invite the parents and god parents to make the sign of the cross on the child's forehead as a gesture of blessing and welcome.

## Part Two: Liturgy of the Word.

**First Reading:** Jeremiah 29:11-14 *When you seek me, you shall find me.*

### **Anointing with Chrism**

**Priest;** God the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ has freed you from sin, given you a new birth by water and the Holy Spirit, and welcomed you into his people. I now anoint you with Chrism of Salvation. As Christ was anointed Priest, Prophet and King, so may you live as a member of his Body, sharing everlasting life. Amen

## **The Christening Gown**

You have become a new creation, clothed in Christ. See in this Christening Gown the outward sign of your inner dignity. With your family and friends to help you along the way of Life, we pray that you will bring the beauty and dignity that you have today into everlasting life. Amen



## The Christening Candle

The priest gives a lighted candle to the parents to signify that Christ our Light will show us the way through life.



**Priest:** Receive the light of Christ.

Parents and Godparents, this light is entrusted to you to be kept burning brightly. Your child has been enlightened by Christ. May your child always walk as a child of that Light. May the flame of faith and compassion be alive in your child's heart. And when the Lord comes, may your child to out to meet Him with all the Saints in Heaven. **Amen** 

## **Blessing of the Senses**

The parents make the sign of the cross over the child's ears and mouth.

May the Lord bless your Child with understanding, wisdom, gentleness, strength and generosity. May Jesus who made the deaf hear and the dumb speak soon touch your ears to receive His Word and your mouth to proclaim His Gospel, to the praise and glory of the Father. **Amen.** 

### **Renewal of Baptismal Promises.**

**Priest;** Parents, God-parents and friends you have come here to present your child for baptism. By water and the Holy Spirit your child is to receive the gift of new life from God who is Love. You must make it your constant care and concern to bring your child up in the practice of the faith. As you publicly declare your intention to hand on your faith to your child, I now ask you;

**Priest:** Do you reject Evil in all it's forms?

Parents and Godparents: I do

**Priest:** Do you believe in God the father, the creator of Heaven and earth?

Parents and Godparents: I do

**Priest:** Do you believe in Jesus Christ and resolve to try to live his Gospel of Truth, Justice and Love?

Parents and Godparents: I do

**Priest:** Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the Communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and life everlasting.

Parents and Godparents: I do.

**Priest:** This is our faith that we are all children of the universe, created equally in the sight of God and that this child is a child of God. Help us to live our faith and to love one another as God loves us. We ask this through Christ, Our Lord. Amen.
